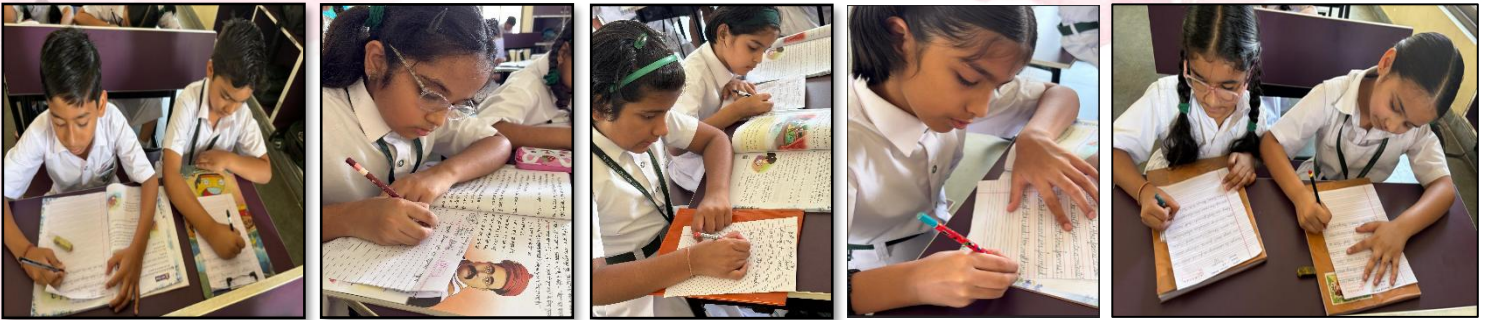

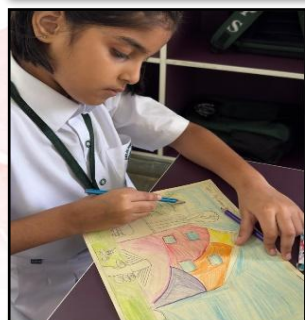
Cheerful Comeback

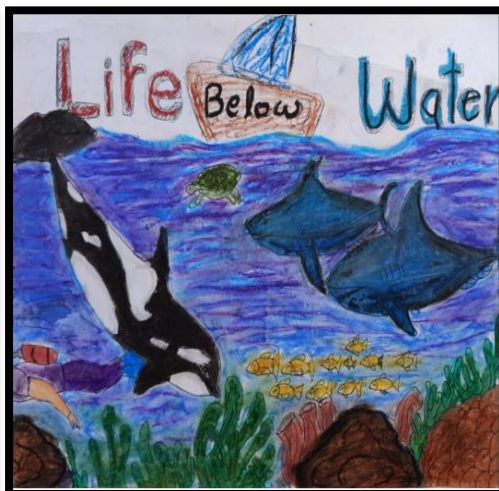

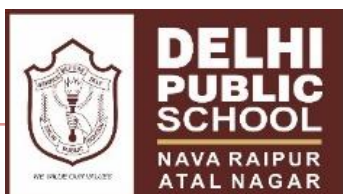
